I understand that if my pet is infested with **FLEAS**, they will be treated prior to the procedure with Capstar (\$5.12-\$5.65), and I will pay for the procedure. We recommend follow-up treatment with Frontline Plus® and it will be offered at the time of discharge.

Testing for **Feline Leukemia Virus & Feline Immunodeficiency Virus (FeLV & FIV)** is strongly encouraged. In the United States, Feline Leukemia is the second largest killer of cats and up to one in 12 cats test positive for FIV. Early detection of these serious diseases is an important aspect of caring for your cat(s) and preventing the virus's spread. By knowing the FeLV/FIV infection status of all cats, we can help pet owners make critical decisions about medical care, protect the health of both FeLV/FIV positive and negative cats, and give cat owners peace of mind. FeLV is transmitted by liking, biting and sneezing and is the most common cause of cancer, various blood disorders, and immune deficiency in cats all which hinders the cat's ability to protect itself against other infections. FIV is a chronic infection of cats similar to human HIV/AIDS and is passed when one cat bites another.

We recommend that **pre-anesthetic blood tests** be performed prior to the administration of anesthesia. Though your pet may appear healthy and happy, he/she may have underlying symptoms of a disease or ailment. The blood testing helps us evaluate liver & kidney function as well as detect early signs of diabetes. All these conditions can contribute to complications in anesthesia and surgery.

I understand this option is an additional fee of \$34.00 and **would like my cat to have blood work** as an added method of safety.
